

Faculty/School-Specific Invitation Criteria and Selection Priorities

1. Faculty of Business and Management (FBM)

1.1 Eligibility Requirements

- 1.1.1 Scored at least 80% of the total marks in English in NCEE;
- 1.1.2 Scored at least 65% of the total marks in Mathematics in NCEE;
- 1.1.3 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.

1.2 Priority Conditions

Priority will be given to FBM students who meet one or more of the following:

- 1.2.1 Ranked within the top 20% of the overall Year-1 art/science new students from each province or city in NCEE;
- 1.2.2 Scored at least 70% of the total marks in Mathematics in NCEE;
- 1.2.3 Received awards at the provincial level or above in recognized competitions such as:
 - a) MIT Blastoff Inventathon;
 - b) Knowledge at Wharton High School Investment Competition;
 - c) National Economics Challenge (NEC) China;
 - d) The International Career Development Conference;
 - e) China Youth Business League;
 - f) National Youth Scientific and Technological Innovation Competition;
 - g) China Youth Robotics Competition;
 - h) China Adolescent Science and Technology Practice Exhibition;
 - i) Olympiads in the subjects of Mathematics and Information Science, etc.
 - j) Other exceptional performances, as determined by FBM.
- 1.2.4 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students;
- 1.2.5 Exceptional cases with strong justification may be considered individually.

2. Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences (FHSS)

2.1 Eligibility Requirements

- 2.1.1 Scored at least 80% of the total marks in English in NCEE;
- 2.1.2 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.

2.2 Priority Conditions

Priority will be given to FHSS students who meet one or more of the following:

- 2.2.1 Ranked within the top 20% of the overall Year-1 art/science new students from each province or city in NCEE;
- 2.2.2 Scored at least 80% of the total marks in Chinese in NCEE;
- 2.2.3 Demonstrated excellence in national or provincial competitions (e.g., essay or digital media contests);
- 2.2.4 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.

3. Faculty of Science and Technology (FST)

3.1 Eligibility Requirements

- 3.1.1 Achieved at least 70% of the total marks in Mathematics in NCEE;
- 3.1.2 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.

3.2 Priority Conditions

Priority will be given to FST students who meet one or more of the following:

- 3.2.1 Ranked within the top 20% of the overall Year-1 art/science new students from each province or city in NCEE;
- 3.2.2 Scored highly in Mathematics or Physics or Biology or Chemistry in NCEE;
- 3.2.3 Scored at least 80% of the total marks in English in NCEE;
- 3.2.4 Received awards in national/provincial Olympiads (Math/Physics/Informatics/Biology/Chemistry) during their study in high school;
- 3.2.5 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.

4. School of Culture and Creativity (SCC)

4.1 Eligibility Requirements

- 4.1.1 Scored at least 70% of the total marks in English in NCEE;
- 4.1.2 Scored at least 60% of the total marks in Mathematics in NCEE;
- 4.1.3 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.

4.2 Priority Conditions

Priority will be given to SCC students who meet one or more of the following:

- 4.2.1 Ranked within the top 20% of the overall Year-1 art/science new students from each province or city in NCEE;
- 4.2.2 Scored at least 80% of the total marks in English in NCEE;
- 4.2.3 Scored at least 70% of the total marks in Mathematics in NCEE;
- 4.2.4 Received awards in creative arts or design at provincial/national/international level competitions, leadership qualities, or other exceptional performances determined by SCC;
- 4.2.5 Faculty/School can set proper equivalent benchmarks for international and other students.
